- Purpose: Test comprehension, reasoning skills, and aptitude needed for legal • education (not prior knowledge).
- **Duration:** 2 hours
- Questions: 120 multiple-choice questions
- swer Que i.e Marks: 1 mark per question; -0.25 for every wrong answer
- Subjects (5 sections):
 - 1. English Language
 - 2. Current Affairs, including General Knowledge
 - 3. Legal Reasoning
 - 4. Logical Reasoning
 - 5. Quantitative Techniques

Section-Wise Breakdown

- 1. English Language
 - Passages: ~450 words (from fiction and non-fiction)
 - **Skills Tested:**
 - Comprehend main points, arguments, and viewpoints.
 - Draw inferences and conclusions.
 - Summarise passages.
 - Compare arguments/viewpoints.
 - Understand word/phrase meanings in context.

2. Current Affairs Including General Knowledge

Passages: ~450 words (from news, journals, non-fiction). 0

- Topics Covered:
 - Contemporary events (India & world).
 - Arts and culture.
 - International affairs.
 - Historical events of significance.
- No prior legal knowledge required (beyond what's in the passage).

3. Legal Reasoning

- **Passages:** ~450 words (legal matters, policy questions, moral issues).
- Skills Tested:
 - Identify and infer rules/principles in the passage.
 - Apply rules to fact situations.
 - Understand changes in rules and their effects.
- No legal knowledge needed; general awareness of legal/moral issues helps.

4. Logical Reasoning

- **Passages:** ~450 words (short texts).
- Skills Tested:
 - Recognise arguments, premises, and conclusions.
 - Analyse reasoning patterns and assess arguments.
 - Draw inferences and apply them to new scenarios.
 - Identify relationships, analogies, contradictions, and equivalence.

5. Quantitative Techniques

- **Content:** Numerical data in short texts or facts.
- Skills Tested:
 - Derive and manipulate numerical information.
